Many Hams swear by them and many Hams swear at them. Probably the cause of the great debate about "antenna tuners" is the fact that they really don't tune anything. A good name for the device would be "TRANSMATCH". After all it TRANS-forms one impedance to another it does not fool the transmitter it Match-es it.

If the antenna is to short (Capacitive reactance) the tuner adds inductive reactance. If the antenna is too long (Inductive reactance) it adds capacitive reactance. When both reactances are the same then we have a match.

The loss you may encounter by using the trans match is really negligible on HF after all You would have to lose half your power before someone could tell the difference (3db).
