ARES brief -

- New computers for Covenant campus Dell Optiplex 3080 with 20 monitors were delivered. Retail price for the 3 systems totaled about \$2,700.
- Some progress on NinoTNC configuration. Covenant donated over \$800 for the purchase
- Covenant ECC room undergoing updates, will require radio station to be removed temporarily.
- Fall SET is coming in October, rumored to be a traffic handing exercise possibly using repeaters
- A list of microwave equipment to complete Covenant Mackinaw and the county communications trailer was requested by the county Emergency Manager. The list was sent to him with the help of Jeff KB8SWR. EM is looking for funding to complete the project. (\$2,700)
